School Attendance – Good attendance at school helps our students perform better academically, have more positive peer relationships and feel more connected to school staff and activities. We hope to see all our students thrive and grow throughout the year, and good attendance at school is a major factor to achieving success at school. We understand that students do get sick so please follow the guidelines for returning to school after illness—students with fever of 100.4 or higher, vomiting or diarrhea need to stay home. Snow and Cold Weather – Winter has arrived and we want to share our policy for outdoor recesses here at Tavelli. If the temperature outside is 12 degrees or above (with the wind chill) students will be going outside for recess. Please make sure your student comes to school with cold weather gear—boots, hat, gloves, coat (all marked with names) so they can enjoy their time outside. Here are our guidelines for outdoor play:

- During snowy days, our focus is that students stay warm, safe, and reasonably dry.
 - If students don't have appropriate snow gear, they won't be able to play on the field
 - Students need to wear boots, snow pants and gloves to play on the field
- No throwing snow or snowballs
- Building snowmen and forts is encouraged.
- Sliding and climbing safely on designated snow piles by the Spark Lab is allowed
- No sliding on the big hill
