- **4.** The State Immunization Exclusion Date is Approaching The State of Colorado's exclusion date is Tuesday, November 1st. This means that any student who is not up to date on immunizations will not be able to attend school until their immunizations are up to date, have a scheduled appointment for immunizations, or have completed the exemption requirement. - **9.** A Few Reminders for Parents If your child is absent from school, please call our attendance line at 488-6726 to let us know your child will be out of school for the day. The office needs daily notification of any absence. In case of extended absences, please let us know when your child will return. If your child will be changing after school dismissal plans, please be sure to give the office a call to explain the change. Breakfast begins every morning at 8:20, students may arrive on the playground at 8:30, please do not drop your student off to the playground any earlier than that, as there is no supervision before that time. Classes begin at 8:50.
