

- 2. Picture Retake Day Student photos are going home this week for those who purchased packages from Skillman Studios. Our retake day is Tuesday morning, November 1st. If you were absent on September 20th, or are new to our school, you will need to have your picture taken, regardless of purchase. If you have already purchased a package and are requesting a retake, you must return the original package in full the the reason for the retake clearly stated on the package. - **4.** Halloween Celebrations at Tavelli Each classroom will be celebrating Monday, October 31st. Students may wear costumes to school; however, we ask that you make sure your student can comfortably take care of themselves throughout the day when they are wearing their costumes. - **5.** The State Immunization Exclusion Date is Approaching The State of Colorado's exclusion date is Tuesday, November 1st. This means that any student who is not up to date on immunizations will not be able to attend school until their immunizations are up to date, have a scheduled appointment for immunizations, or have completed the exemption requirement. - **6. School of Choice** School of Choice for the 2023-2024 academic year will open on Tuesday, November 1st. Students who have been accepted school of choice for this school year do not need to reapply. However, if there are younger siblings who will be attending next year an application is necessary. The first round for school of choice will close at 11:59 p.m. on Thursday, December 15th.



- 7. Our Lost and Found Collection is Growing As the weather changes, so does our collection of lost and found items. If your child has lost a coat, sweatshirt, hat, lunch box.....please contact the office to make arrangements to come look through our lost and found items. Want to ensure that your child's belongings are returned? Include their name on an inside tag—first name, last initial is great, and we will return the item to their teacher. Of four large bags of items, names were only included on four separate pieces of clothing.
- 8. Please Keep Your Child Home if They Are Not Feeling Well If your child is experiencing any signs of illness (fever, chills, cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, fatigue, muscle or body aches, headache, sore throat, congestion, runny nose, nausea, vomiting or diarrhea) please keep them home and contact the attendance line at 488-6726. Our Health Office Technician, Monica will be contacting families with ill students. If your student is home with COVID-like symptoms and hasn't had a known exposure, you may administer an at-home COVID test. Please take a photo of the result and email it to Monica Smith, our Health Technician at msmith@psdschools.org Thanks for your help with this.
- 9. A Few Reminders for Parents If your child is absent from school, please call our attendance line at 488-6726 to let us know your child will be out of school for the day. The office needs daily notification of any absence. In case of extended absences, please let us know when your child will return. If your child will be changing after school dismissal plans, please be sure to give the office a call to explain the change. Breakfast begins every morning at 8:20, students may arrive on the playground at 8:30, please do not drop your student off to the playground any earlier than that, as there is no supervision before that time. Classes begin at 8:50.
- 10. Cash for Caps If you have milk delivered from Morning Fresh Dairy, we can use your clean caps! Morning Fresh will give us five cents per cap turned in. There is a collection box for your clean caps available in the Tavelli Office.
- **11.** Link Your King Soopers Card to Tavellil By linking your King Soopers card, Tavelli PTO will collect 5% of your grocery bill. Check out the Tavelli PTO website for instructions.
- 12. Let's be Good Neighbors If you are coming to school to volunteer, or you are having lunch with your child and will be on the premises for some time, please make sure you haven't parked in front of our Miramont Drive neighbors' mailboxes. The post office requires that 5 feet on either side of a mailbox be clear to ensure mail delivery. If you are coming to school after 9:15 and leaving before 2:15, it is perfectly fine to park in front of our building in the bus lane. Thanks for your cooperation!
