Choose the *Current Student and Family Data Verification* drop down for all instructions needed to update your information. This is an easy way to ensure that we have all the current contact and health information for your student.
- 12. A Few Reminders for Parents If your child is absent from school, please call our attendance line at 488-6726 to let us know your child will be out of school for the day. The office needs daily notification of any absence. In case of extended absences, please let us know when your child will return. If your child will be changing after school dismissal plans, please be sure to give the office a call to explain the change. Breakfast will be served every morning beginning at 8:20, students may arrive on the playground at 8:35, please do not drop your student off to the playground any earlier than that, as there is no supervision before that time. Classes begin at 8:50.
