- 2. Conferences Are Next Week** – Just a reminder, there is no school next Thursday for PK-5 graders and Friday for K-12 grade students due to Parent-Teacher Conferences. You should already have a scheduled time for your conference, if you haven't made that appointment, please contact your child's teacher. Thanks for being a valuable piece in your child's education.
- 3. It's Turkey Round Up Time** – Each year the Food Bank provides services to nearly 40,000 residents of Larimer County, many of whom are PSD students. More than 2,500 turkeys are needed this fall season. Please consider donating a frozen turkey or plant-based alternative for our families. You can bring your frozen turkey to school Thursday, November 18 before school and drop it off when you drop off your child. 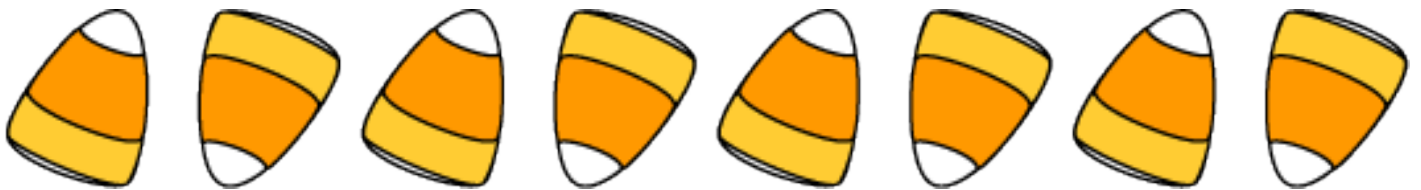
Choose the *Current Student and Family Data Verification* drop down for all instructions needed to update your information. This is an easy way to ensure that we have all the current contact and health information for your student.

**8. Please, Do Not Send Your Child to School if They Are Sick** – If your child is experiencing any of the COVID-19 symptoms which include: fever or chills, cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, fatigue, muscle or body aches, headache, new loss of taste or smell, sore throat, congestion or runny nose, nausea, vomiting, or diarrhea please keep them home. We will contact parents of children who come to school with any of the above symptoms and they will be sent home. We are trying very hard to keep our students and staff healthy during this time. **9. A Few Reminders for Parents** – If your child is absent from school, please call our attendance line at 488-6726 to let us know your child will be out of school for the day. The office needs daily notification of any absence. In case of extended absences, please let us know when your child will return. If your child will be changing after school dismissal plans, please be sure to give the office a call to explain the change. Breakfast will be served every morning beginning at 8:20, students may arrive on the playground at 8:35, please do not drop your student off to the playground any earlier than that, as there is no supervision before that time. Classes begin at 8:50.

**10. Cash for Caps** – If you have milk delivered from Morning Fresh Dairy, we can use your clean caps! Morning Fresh will give us 5 cents per cap turned in. There is a collection box for your **clean** caps available in the Tavelli Office. 🐾
