1. All Students Can Enjoy Free Breakfast and Lunch – Any student ages 18 and under can enjoy free breakfast and lunch until December. 2. A Note About Our Staggered Pick-Up Times – Due to the fact that most students are arriving at school in private vehicles, we have staggered pick up times to help with traffic flows at school. If your child is in grade K-1, their dismissal time is 3:15. Older siblings will also be dismissed at this time if they have a brother or sister in grade K-1. All other students in grades 2-5 will be dismissed at 3:28. Please do not arrive early if you have an older student, we are trying to keep traffic moving as quickly as possible. Preschoolers are dismissed at 3:30 and their older siblings will be picked up at that time.

3. Keyboarding Practice Contest for Grades 1-5 -- Keyboarding is a lifelong skill, and the sooner students can master it, the better. So, we are having a grade level contest to reward those classes who are making keyboarding practice a weekly habit. Here's how students can participate: Practice in Typing Club for at least 20 minutes per week. If a homeroom class has at least 75% participation, it qualifies for the practice contest.
