You can sign in with your student's ID number and password to view the books they have checked out, due dates, replacement costs, and more. A book can be renewed for two more weeks here as well. If a book is lost or damaged, please contact Linda Foreman in the office. (<u>lforeman@psdschools.org</u>) She will then mark it as lost, and you will be able to pay for it on SchoolPay or over the phone with a credit card. Student Absences -- When your student is missing school, please call the attendance line, 970-488-6726 or report the absence on parentvue. If your child has a fever of 100.4 or higher or has vomiting or diarrhea they must remain out of school until 24 hours have passed since the last symptoms. In the case of fevers, students must be fever-free for 24 hours without fever-reducing medication. Thanks for helping us control the spread of illness!
