

How to see what library books your student has checked out: — Parents, to see the status of your student's library books, please click https://lib.psdschools.org/Library/Home, and click the Parents tab. You can sign in with your student's ID number and password to view the books they have checked out, due dates, replacement costs, and more. A book can be renewed for two more weeks here as well. If a book is lost or damaged, please contact Linda Foreman in the office. (lforeman@psdschools.org) She will then mark it as lost, and you will be able to pay for it on SchoolPay or over the phone with a credit card. Car Pick Up – We notice that several cars arrive in our back loop 30 minutes before our school day ends. This is fine, however we do ask that you turn your vehicle off during this time, as our classrooms that have entries to the back parking lot are affected by the vehicle emissions. Student Absences -- When your student is missing school, please call the attendance line, 970-488-6726 or report the absence on parentvue. If your child has a fever of 100.4 or higher or has vomiting or diarrhea they must remain out of school until 24 hours have passed since the last symptoms. In the case of fevers, students must be fever-free for 24 hours without fever-reducing medication. Thanks for helping us control the spread of illness!
