Currently, one out of every 27 students is experiencing homelessness or housing insecurity in our district. 7. Cash for Caps – If you have milk delivered from Morning Fresh Dairy, we can use your clean caps! Morning Fresh will give us five cents per cap turned in. There is a collection box for your clean caps available in the Tavelli Office.
