

- 1. Please Leave Your Personal Items and Pokemon Cards at Home Please don't bring your personal toys, games or Pokemon Cards to school. Things get broken, or go missing and create a lot of problems in the classroom. Thank you for your help with this.
- 2. Kindergarten Information Night We will be hosting an informational night Wednesday, January 12<sup>th</sup> at 5:30 p.m. for all incoming Kindergarteners in the 2022-2023 school year. More details will follow. Online registration for the 2022 school year opens Monday, January 3<sup>rd</sup>. In-person registration is Thursday, January 20<sup>th</sup> from 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Documents required at registration are birth certificate, immunization paperwork and proof of address.
- **3. Get Involved With the PTO** If you are interested in becoming more involved in school activities a good place to start is with our PTO. This group is seeking new members to share in the work that benefits our students, staff and Tavelli Community. - **4.** School of Choice Deadline is January 21st If your child has already been accepted to Tavelli as a School of Choice student for the 2021-2022 school year, there is no need to submit another application for next year. A school of choice application is necessary for any younger siblings or new students that live outside our attendance area. Fifth grade students who will not be attending their neighborhood middle school will also need to register for school of choice. The first consideration period deadline is noon on Friday, January 21st. - **5. Mobile Bus Vaccinations Rescheduled at Tavelli** The Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment has rescheduled the mobile clinic at Tavelli. Thursday, January 6<sup>th</sup> the bus will return to Tavelli from 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. to provide the COVID 19 vaccination and a flu shot, if needed. Parents must be present in order for their children to be vaccinated. The mobile clinic will return January 27<sup>th</sup> to provide the 2<sup>nd</sup> dose for all those vaccinated on January 6. - **6. COVID Information** Thanks to all of you for keeping your kids home when they have any symptoms of illness. If your child has <u>any</u> signs of illness, you must keep them at home and if symptoms persist or worsen, they must have a COVID test to return. Larimer County Health has a drive through test site at Timberline Church from 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Monday through Friday. This testing is free. <u>Please do not administer an at-home test to your child, PSD does not accept those.</u> Thanks for your continued support as we work hard to keep kids in school and healthy.
- 7. PSD expectations for remote learning in all schools -- The district's focus is to have all students participate in in-person learning at schools as much as possible. However, some students may miss being in school because of illness, quarantine, an emergency or other circumstances. PSD wants to ensure students can continue learning remotely when they can't be at school regardless of the reason for the absence. Teachers and staff will do their best to support students who are learning online.

- **8. Free Therapy for Colorado Youths -** Every Colorado youth is eligible for three free therapy sessions. Youth and their parents can visit the <u>I Matter platform</u> to take a confidential online survey about their mental health and schedule sessions with a licensed behavioral health clinician, primarily online over telehealth. State law allows youth ages 12 and up to use the platform independently; youth ages 11 and younger will need their parent or guardian's consent to sign up. Learn more on the <u>I Matter website</u>.
- **9.** Extended Absences Due to Illness or Quarantine If your student should have to quarantine, there are some things we want you to be aware of to access learning resources while they are at home. Your child's teacher will provide materials to work on during their absence; please contact them if your child needs a laptop or a mi-fi to access the internet. We can also provide breakfast and lunch for pick-up at the school, contact the office at 488-6725 to order a lunch or breakfast.
- 10. A Few Reminders for Parents If your child is absent from school, please call our attendance line at 488-6726 to let us know your child will be out of school for the day. The office needs daily notification of any absence. In case of extended absences, please let us know when your child will return. If your child will be changing after school dismissal plans, please be sure to give the office a call to explain the change. Breakfast will be served every morning beginning at 8:20, students may arrive on the playground at 8:35, please do not drop your student off to the playground any earlier than that, as there is no supervision before that time. Classes begin at 8:50.
- 11. Cash for Caps If you have milk delivered from Morning Fresh Dairy, we can use your clean caps! Morning Fresh will give us 5 cents per cap turned in. There is a collection box for your clean caps available in the Tavelli Office.
- **12.** Link Your King Soopers Card to Tavelli! By linking your King Soopers card, Tavelli PTO will collect 5% of your grocery bill. Check out the Tavelli PTO website for instructions.
