5. Masking Requirements In PSD – Although the mask mandate has been lifted for PSD schools, there are some situations that masks are still necessary:

- On school buses, <u>according to a federal mandate</u>, students and staff may not get on a bus without a mask.
- In Early Childhood Education classrooms and facilities, <u>according to federal mandate.</u>
- Those positive or required to quarantine for COVID must isolate for five full days and return on day six only if symptoms are improving. They must wear a mask on days six through 10, according to state and county health guidance.
- Those who have decided not to test when symptomatic according to <u>Return to Learn</u> guidelines must wear a mask on days 6 through 10.
- When students become symptomatic at school, they will be required to wear a mask in the precautionary room. When families are called to pick up their student, please let them know that symptomatic students are required to wear a mask, so families are not surprised when they arrive.

If students or staff have a medical mask exemption (for any situation in which masks are still required) and are not able to wear a mask, they would need to remain home for days 6 through 10. 7. PSD Is Now Accepting Home COVID Tests -- However, there are a few important requirements for using at-home test results:

- Families/Staff must submit a photo of the positive or negative test result with the name, date, and time test was taken written directly on the test card to the health office. *Picture should be taken at the time of the reading of results. It is important to follow all package directions that accompany the test.*
- Students/Staff must still follow the next step of Return to Learn, which is that symptoms must be resolved OR improved AND have not had any fever, vomiting, or diarrhea in the last 24 hours without use of medication. Student must be able to wear a mask reliably for days 6 10 to return.

If your student wouldn't have been considered well enough to be at school in pre-COVID days, they aren't well enough to be at school now, even with a negative test result. Please see the attached information—how sick is too sick?

8. A Few Reminders for Parents – If your child is absent from school, please call our attendance line at 488-6726 to let us know your child will be out of school for the day. The office needs daily notification of any absence. In case of extended absences, please let us know when your child will return. If your child will be changing after school dismissal plans, please be sure to give the office a call to explain the change. Breakfast will be served every morning beginning at 8:20, students may arrive on the playground at 8:35, please do not drop your student off to the playground any earlier than that, as there is no supervision before that time. Classes begin at 8:50.

9. Cash for Caps – If you have milk delivered from Morning Fresh Dairy, we can use your clean caps! Morning Fresh will give us 5 cents per cap turned in. There is a collection box for your clean caps available in the Tavelli Office.
