

- **3.** Vision and Hearing Screening Our screenings will take place Thursday, February 24. If your child wears glasses, please make sure they bring them to school on that day.
- **4.** Class Valentine's Parties Please check with your child's teacher for information on the class Valentine's Parties. All parties will be held Monday, February 14th, but times may vary.
- 5. Take the Healthy Kids 5210+ Challengel Every year, Tavelli students participate in this challenge, along with nearly 100 other northern Colorado schools. What is it? The 5210+ challenge teaches healthy daily habits, which are: 5 fruits and vegetables, 2 hours or less of screen time, 1 hour or more of physical activity, 0 sugary drinks, and + nine or more hours of sleep. - 7. PSD Is Now Accepting Home COVID Tests -- However, there are a few important requirements for using at-home test results:
 - Families/Staff must submit a photo of the positive or negative test result with the name, date, and time test was taken written directly on the test card to the health office. Picture should be taken at the time of the reading of results. It is important to follow all package directions that accompany the test.
 - Students/Staff must still follow the next step of Return to Learn, which is that symptoms must be resolved OR improved AND have not had any fever, vomiting, or



diarrhea in the last 24 hours without use of medication. Student must be able to wear a mask reliably for days 6 - 10 to return.

If your student wouldn't have been considered well enough to be at school in pre-COVID days, they aren't well enough to be at school now, even with a negative test result. Please see the attached information—how sick is too sick?

8. PSD expectations for remote learning in all schools -- The district's focus is to have all students participate in in-person learning at schools as much as possible. However, some students may miss being in school because of illness, quarantine, an emergency or other circumstances. PSD wants to ensure students can continue learning remotely when they can't be at school regardless of the reason for the absence. Teachers and staff will do their best to support students who are learning online.

- 9. Extended Absences Due to Illness or Quarantine If your student should have to quarantine, there are some things we want you to be aware of to access learning resources while they are at home. Your child's teacher will provide materials to work on during their absence; please contact them if your child needs a laptop or a mi-fi to access the internet. We can also provide breakfast and lunch for pick-up at the school, contact the office at 488-6725 to order a lunch or breakfast.
- 10. A Few Reminders for Parents If your child is absent from school, please call our attendance line at 488-6726 to let us know your child will be out of school for the day. The office needs daily notification of any absence. In case of extended absences, please let us know when your child will return. If your child will be changing after school dismissal plans, please be sure to give the office a call to explain the change. Breakfast will be served every morning beginning at 8:20, students may arrive on the playground at 8:35, please do not drop your student off to the playground any earlier than that, as there is no supervision before that time. Classes begin at 8:50.
- 11. Cash for Caps If you have milk delivered from Morning Fresh Dairy, we can use your clean caps! Morning Fresh will give us 5 cents per cap turned in. There is a collection box for your clean caps available in the Tavelli Office.
