

3. CMAS Testing Will Begin In April -- The Colorado Measures of Academic Success testing window opens in March/April. Tavelli will be administering this standardized test in April in grades 3-5. We will be testing Tuesday-Thursday mornings the weeks of April 5th, and 12th. The week of April 19thwe will be testing 5th graders.
