5. AR Reading Challenge -- Every quarter, students who have a reading level above 1.0 are encouraged to reach and surpass their independent reading goal using an online program called Accelerated Reader (AR). Students pick books that are in their reading zone, which is determined by their STAR Reading diagnostic tests. Books in our library have color-coded dots on the lower spine indicating difficulty levels which helps students pick the right book for them. After reading each book, students take an online AR quiz and when the quiz is passed, receive points to help them reach their goal. Once their goal is met, students are encouraged to double it, triple it, or more! Students receive media/technology points, recognition, and

prizes for reaching and exceeding their goals. Most importantly, students get the practice they need for mastery and enjoyment of reading. 6. Spring State Assessments -- Student assessment is a meaningful part of student learning and instructional planning. Assessments allow educators to monitor student progress and the effectiveness of instructional strategies. At certain times throughout the year, students take required assessments that fulfill legislative requirements or district guidelines. The spring state testing window for grades 3-11 is April 1-26 with exact dates dependent on grade level and school site.
