- 1. The Scholastic Buy One Get One Free Book Fair is Coming in May** – We will be having an online sale again this spring. Books are two for the price of one! Look for the flyer coming home in Thursday notes the week of May 25th. 🐾
- 2. Our Playground is Under Construction Again!** – Our new tower has come in and is being installed this week. The construction area has been cordoned off with temporary fencing. Completion time is about a week.
- 3. Sign up for Busing for the 2022-2023 School Year** -- Poudre School District aims to transport as many students as possible to and from school. To ensure that families needing transportation receive this service, riders must now apply for busing each year, even if they've had busing before. Families may request transportation [online here](#). Submitting a request is not a guarantee of services. Even with ongoing recruiting efforts and the hiring of additional bus operators, PSD is still busing fewer students than in previous years because of a reduction in routes due to the ongoing driver shortage.
- 4. Dream Team Field Trip** – To celebrate another successful year in Dream Team, students will be taking a field trip Thursday, May 19th. Students with good attendance in the program will receive permission slips in the coming weeks. 🐾
- 5. Free and Reduced Meal Program** – It's not too late to apply for the Free and Reduced Meal Program for this school year. By doing so your student's approval to the program carries over for

the first 30 days of next school year. Also, there are advantages to being on this program with discounts given throughout our community for student summer programs. Check out <https://www.fcgov.com/recreation/reducedfeeprogram> website for more information. The before and after school program, AlphaBest, also gives a 15% discount. Apply online at www.myschoolapps.com. Please note that August 1, 2022, is the first day you can apply online for the 2022-2023 school year. Families do have to apply each school year unless they receive a letter stating otherwise.

6. Registration for kindergarten is now open, [start here](#). Kindergarten is an exciting and important first step on your student's educational journey. In PSD, you'll find students are supported in many ways with caring teachers and staff, positive school, and classroom culture, as well as a collaborative, safe and welcoming learning environment.

Children must be 5 years old on or before Oct. 1, 2022, to register for kindergarten in the 2022-23 school year.

7. Traffic in Front of the School – Just a reminder, please be considerate of our neighbors and refrain from parking in front of driveways. As a courtesy to our other drivers who have patiently waited in line to pick up their children, please do not make U-turns on Miramont. This is a safety issue and keeping our students safe is our priority. Thank you for your help with this.

8. The Playground and Field are Open After School Hours – The playground and field area are for public use after our school day ends at 4:00 p.m. We want to ensure that we get all our students safely home and out of the area. Thanks for your support.

9. Some Reminders for Parents – If your child is absent from school, please call our attendance line at 488-6726 to let us know your child will be out of school for the day. The office needs daily notification of any absence. In case of extended absences, please let us know when your child will return. If your child will be changing after school dismissal plans, please be sure to give the office a call to explain the change. Breakfast will be served every morning beginning at 8:20, students may arrive on the playground at 8:30, please do not drop your student off to the playground any earlier than that, as there is no supervision before that time. Classes begin at 8:50.

10. Cash for Caps – If you have milk delivered from Morning Fresh Dairy, we can use your clean caps! Morning Fresh will give us 5 cents per cap turned in. There is a collection box for your **clean** caps available in the Tavelli Office. 🌸
