- Scroll down to the eWallet section and click on *GET STARTED*
- The Book Fair eWallet page appears. Next click on *GO to eWallet*

- Create an eWallet account and fund with your desired amount
  - If the book fair is in school, be sure to fill in the Teacher Name as this will make it faster at checkout

Once you have created your eWallet – share it with friends and family who may help your child build their home library.

- The option to share will come up automatically and you can copy and paste the unique URL into an email or social media post.

Now it's time to shop!

- Add the titles you want to the cart.
- Select eWallet as payment.

Enter the amount you are using and continue to checkout. Make sure to do this before our Fair ends on 5 / 7 /2021 at Midnight Eastern Time so Tavelli will receive 25% back!

Please make sure to download your proof of address, birth certificate and immunization records when you register your child. Without those documents, registration is not considered complete.

**Last Day of School** – Wednesday, May 26 is the last day of school for the 2020-2021 school year. That day will be a half day for students, and they will be released at noon. No lunches will be served on that day; buses will pick up those students who have bus transportation.
