8. Sign up for Busing for the 2022-2023 School Year – All students will need to sign up for the bus next year, whether they rode the bus this year or not. Please go to this website: https://eweb2.psdschools.org/Transportation_BussingRequest/ to sign up. The transportation department is working hard to accommodate all students who need a bus.

9. Free and Reduced Meal Program – It's not too late to apply for the Free and Reduced Meal Program for this school year. By doing so your student's approval to the program carries over for the first 30 days of next school year. Also, there are advantages to being on this program with discounts given throughout our community for student summer programs.
