

- **8.** Code of Conduct Acknowledgement All parents/guardians accessing their parentvue account will be prompted to sign the code of conduct before they have access to that account. In order to complete the acknowledgement, follow these steps:
 - Log into the ParentVUE parent portal. https://www.psdschools.org/ParentVUE
 - Read the Acknowledgement text box.
 - Click on the link at the bottom of the page to download the 2023-2024 Code of Conduct.
 - Write your name on the signature field exactly as it appears on your ParentVUE account.
 - Click "Yes." Parents/guardians will not gain access to ParentVUE until they electronically sign the acknowledgment.
- **9.** A Few Reminders for Parents If your child is absent from school, please call our attendance line at 970-488-6726 or enter the absence on parentvue.. If your child is changing after school dismissal plans, please be sure to give the office a call to explain the change. Breakfast is served every morning beginning at 7:55, students may arrive on the playground at 8:05, please do not drop your student off to the playground any earlier than that, as there is no supervision before that time. Classes begin at 8:25.
- **10.** Cash for Caps If you have milk delivered from Morning Fresh Dairy, we can use your clean caps! Morning Fresh will give us 5 cents per cap turned in. There is a collection box for your clean caps available in the Tavelli Office.
- 11. Let's be Good Neighbors If you are coming to school to volunteer, or you are having lunch with your child and will be on the premises for some time, please make sure you haven't parked in front of our Miramont Drive neighbors' mailboxes.
