1. Library Check Out for 3-5 Grade Students -- The library is now open for reserves and pickup for Tavelli 3rd-5th Graders! This will work best using their PSD computer or if they are signed in to Chrome with their PSD account. If your students are in grades 3-5 at Tavelli, they can reserve Tavelli Library books from home and pick them up on Fridays between 9-3! Here's how it works: Check with your parents and make sure it's okay to pick up books on Friday. <u>Click here to see how to reserve books online on the Insignia Library System.</u> Reserve 1 or 2 books during the week, before noon on Thursday. We check reserves every day and check the books out to students as they are requested. Come to Tavelli on Friday between 9-3. Look for a cart by the front door with your grade and teacher's name on it. Books are arranged in order alphabetically by students' last names. You will see a slip with your name on it. Please wear a mask. Please socially distance if there are others picking up books when you are here. Return your books in the wagon marked "Book Return". Enjoy your books! Your books will be due for return in two weeks, unless you renew them for another two weeks.
