

- 1. Our First Bell Rings at 8:50 At that time, all students are brought into the building and attendance is taken. If you arrive after this time, even if there are still staff members outside, we ask that you drive around to the front of the building and have your child enter through the front doors. We will sign students in at the office, so we know they are in attendance and we won't contact you for an absence report.
- 2. Running Club Returns! We are offering a smaller version of running club, open to 3-5 Grade students this fall. A bright pink registration form is coming home with all 3rd-5th graders today. We will be limiting the size of running club to 90 runners this fall, so enrollment will be open on a first come-first served basis. - **4.** Save the date! Bring your family and friends to the first Tavelli Rollerland skate party of the year on Thursday evening, October 7th. This is a private party at Rollerland where only Tavelli families, friends and staff are invited. Masks are required, just like in school, but it is sure to be a blast. This is a fundraiser for Tavelli's Dream Team and Media/Technology program. The more people we have, the more money we'll raise for our school. - **5.** Fall is in the Air With the change in weather, more students will be wearing jackets and sweaters to school. Every year we have a mountain of lost and found items that are never claimed. It is very helpful if you include your student's name on their jackets, coats, and sweaters so we can return them. Unmarked and unclaimed items will be donated.
- **6. Update Your Information on Parentvue** It is easy to update your student's information and health conditions by logging onto your parentvue account and clicking on the OLR tab (Online Registration). Choose the *Current Student and Family Data Verification* drop down for all instructions needed to update your information. This is an easy way to ensure that we have all the current contact and health information for your student.
- 7. Please Do Not Park Near Lemay and Lowell We have had some parents parking at the entrance to the Puebla Vista Estates neighborhood for student drop off and pick up. Lowell Lane is the only entrance to the neighborhood and roads and landscaping are maintained by the property owners. Students who live in the neighborhood walk to and from school and the increased traffic in this area has become a safety issue.

Please be considerate of our families and neighbors living in this area and refrain from using this location to drop off or pick up your students. Thanks for your help.

- 8. Parent Pick Up for Preschool We understand that the traffic around our school is challenging at pick up time, however we are asking parents to please follow our established traffic pattern when picking up your children. There is no need to park in the west lot and get out of your vehicle; it is safer and more organized for vehicles to drive through; preschoolers and their siblings will be escorted to your vehicle by our staff members. Please do not enter the west parking lot from Lemay, it is a one-way exit, and we often have vehicles turning north and south out of that lot. Thank you for your patience and understanding.
- **9.** Please, Do Not Send Your Child to School if They Are Sick If your child is experiencing any of the COVID-19 symptoms which include: fever or chills, cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, fatigue, muscle or body aches, headache, new loss of taste or smell, sore throat, congestion or runny nose, nausea, vomiting, or diarrhea please keep them home. We will contact parents of children who come to school with **any of the above symptoms** and they will be sent home. We are trying very hard to keep our students and staff healthy during this time. Thanks for your support.
- 10. A Few Reminders for Parents If your child is absent from school, please call our attendance line at 488-6726 to let us know your child will be out of school for the day. The office needs daily notification of any absence. In case of extended absences, please let us know when your child will return. If your child will be changing after school dismissal plans, please be sure to give the office a call to explain the change. Breakfast will be served every morning beginning at 8:20, students may arrive on the playground at 8:35, please do not drop your student off to the playground any earlier than that, as there is no supervision before that time. Classes begin at 8:50.
- 11. Cash for Caps If you have milk delivered from Morning Fresh Dairy, we can use your clean caps! Morning Fresh will give us 5 cents per cap turned in. There is a collection box for your clean caps available in the Tayelli Office.
