ARRIVAL AND PICK UP

Start Time: 8:50 End Time: 3:28

Arrival and Dismissal Updates: Tavelli currently has 4 buses assigned to Tavelli. We are continually having conversations about how to be the most efficient with traffic and getting students to and from school safely.

- Parents/Guardians need to wear a mask and social distance while in our school.
- If you arrive to school after 8:50 please bring your child to the main entrance/office door. Our start of school bell rings at 8:50. We do not want students outside classroom doors or on the playground once our staff returns to the building to start classes.
- When you arrive at school, continue to pull forward and stay close to the cones and curbs to allow more distance in the thru lane in the back loop.
- Drive slowly and use caution in our loading and unloading areas. Please watch for other cars, students, and staff.
- In our neighborhood we ask for you to be patient and drive slowly on the streets close to our school.
- We will not be loading or unloading students on the Driver's side of the car. This is dangerous and unsafe due to approaching cars. Please have your child ready to unload on the passenger side. The safety of our students and staff is our top priority.
- Please be courteous to our neighbors by not parking in front of driveways and not making Uturns in the middle of the street.

 locked.
