Science/Engineering Lab

In Science/Engineering Lab, kindergarteners are introduced to pushes and pulls and how those affect the motion of objects. Students observe and investigate the effects of what happens when the strength or direction of those pushes and pulls are changed. In the Human Bumper Bowling activity, kindergarteners work together to knock down pins.



In this Sci/Eng Lab Boulder Bounce activity, kindergarteners play a game where they design a solution that protects a model town called Tiny Town from a bouncing-ball "boulder."





In the Sci/Eng Lab, kindergarteners imagine how to design a good monster trap, and then draw their inventions. When their pictures are done, they find a partner to explain the details and how it works.



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Science/Engineering Lab

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In Science/Engineering Lab, second graders explore the different properties of materials used for clothing, such as texture, flexibility, and absorbency. In the Mad Hatter activity, students use this information to design and build a hat that protects them from the Sun.

Greetings from the Tavelli library and computer lab! We have had a great year so far! 1st-5th grade students used Pixie and Wixie and a webcam to design superheroes with their own faces. They are busy reading great library books and moving their superheroes up the AR Reading mountain, (and beyond), as they get closer to their AR reading goals. Students get prizes for reaching 100% of their reading goal. In the computer lab, students are working their way through the code.org coding curriculum for their grade, along with practicing on other apps such as Typing Club, Nitro Type, Pixie, Wixie, Google Slides and Sheets, video editing with WeVideo, and 3D design with TinkerCAD. Students get a strong dose of the four C's, (Communication, Collaboration, Creativity, and Critical Thinking), in all our activities. Students who do their work and fulfill all the requirements in their Google Classroom assignments earn points that they can spend on goodies in the Encore Store.
