1. Kindergarten Registration Scheduled for February 9 -- Registration will be held from 7 a.m. to 6 p.m., at all elementary schools. Parents must register their child at their neighborhood school even if they are applying for a school choice option. Children who will be 5 years old on or before September 15, 2017, are eligible to register. **On the day of registration, parents should bring their child's birth certificate (original or certified preferred), immunization records, proof of residency, and emergency contact information.**

2. Kindergarten Tuition and Scholarships – Tuition for the 2017-18 Kindergarten year will be \$2,750. If you are interested in full day kindergarten for your child, but don't think you can afford the tuition there are a limited number of scholarships available. This year, all scholarships will be handled out of Poudre School District's Finance Department and will be based on the Free/Reduced lunch applications, which will be available in mid-July. Tavelli will have a limited number of scholarships available, which will be awarded on a lottery system. Questions regarding the scholarship process should be directed to the Finance Department at 970-490-3649.

3. Tavelli After School Activity Pickup - Parents, if you are picking your student up from a Tavelli activity after the office closes at 4:00 PM please wait in the foyer. The second set of entry doors will not be unlocked. Your child's teacher for the activity will bring them down and check them out to you when the activity is over. Thank you for your understanding of this important security issue.
