1. Poudre School District Adopts New Start Times – Beginning next year, Tavelli start times will be changing. Our students will begin their day at 7:45 a.m. and end at 2:23 p.m. District Administrators will be meeting in the upcoming weeks to work out details and discuss impacts upon schedules this switch may entail. Be assured that the district is working to make this transition as seamless as possible for all our PSD families. As part of the implementation plan, PSD staff members will work to finalize specific start times for each school. PSD will communicate those new times, and other details of the plan, as quickly as possible over the next several months leading up to the new school year. 2. Blue Ribbon Bumper Stickers – We are sending home Blue Ribbon vinyl bumper stickers today to celebrate our Blue Ribbon Achievement. These are easily removable vinyl bumper stickers and we are proud to share Tavelli students' accomplishments with Fort Collins. One bumper sticker will be going home with each Tavelli family's oldest and/or only student.

3. Original Art Work Coming Home! – If you ordered anything from the Original Works art fund raiser, your child will be bringing it home today. Please check for your merchandise.

4. Our Letter "T" is Filled – Once again, we have filled up our STEAM letter T with positive choices made by Tavelli students. We will have a Spirit Day Friday, December 7th. Bring your favorite board game to school and share it with your classmates.

5. School of Choice – If your children have already been accepted as school of choice and are attending Tavelli this year, there is no need to fill out a school of choice application for them for next year. Younger siblings who have not attended Tavelli must be registered as school of choice students. **If you have moved out of our attendance area and would like to continue to attend Tavelli next year, please fill out a school of choice application for your student.** Applications are found online at www.psdschools.org. **The school of choice deadline for all PSD students is Friday, January 18, 2019.** If you have questions, please contact the Tavelli office, 488-6725.

6. Tavelli Hosting an Open House for Incoming Kindergarten Students – Parents of students entering Kindergarten in August 2019 are invited to stop in during one of our open house dates. We will show you around the school and answer any questions you might have during the tour. Tour times are Tuesday, January 8th from 1:30-3:00 p.m. and Thursday, January 9th from 9:30-11:00 a.m.

7. Kindergarten Orientation – Parents of incoming Kindergarteners are invited to our Orientation on Thursday, January 10th from 5:30-6:30 p.m. We will talk about life as a Tavelli Tiger and share important information. Kindergarten teachers will be on hand to talk about curriculum and what a kindergartener's day looks like. Please join us in the Cafeteria on January 10th.

8. Kindergarten registration scheduled for January 17 – Your child's education adventure is around the corner! Kindergarten registration for students entering school in PSD in fall 2019 is scheduled for Thursday, January 17, 2019. Registration will be held from 7 a.m. to 6 p.m., at all elementary schools. Parents must register their child at their neighborhood school even if they are applying for a school choice option. Children who will be 5 years old on or before September 15, 2019, are eligible to register.

On the day of registration, parents should bring their child's birth certificate (original or certified preferred), immunization records, proof of residency, and emergency contact information.

One-way transportation is provided for kindergarten students attending a half-day program who live more than one mile from their neighborhood school. Round-trip transportation is provided for students in an all-day program who live more than one mile from school. Transportation is not provided for School Choice students (those who attend a school outside their attendance areas).

9. Lost and Found is Leaving the Building! – Once again, we have several bags of lost items here at school. If your child is missing a coat, sweatshirt, hat or other piece of clothing please check our lost and found for these items. We will be donating all unclaimed items December 14th. To ensure that your child gets his or her coat back, please label them. Thank you.

10. Scholastic Book Fair – There is one more chance to purchase books from the Scholastic Book Fair, as it will be open Friday morning from 8:00 a.m. to 9:30 a.m. and from Noon to 5:30 p.m. Books make great gifts! 🌸

11. 5th Grade Musical Coming Up – Tavelli's 5th Graders invite you to their STEAM Encore Music Performance, *Musical Science Jeopardy*. The performances for our school population will be at 10:00 Tuesday, December 4 and 9:30 a.m. Wednesday, December 5. The Tavelli Community is invited to the Wednesday night performance on December 5 at 6:00 p.m.

12. Purchase an Old Chicago Pizza Palz Card– We have a limited number of Old Chicago Pizza Palz cards for sale in the Tavelli Office. When you purchase a card for \$11, you can receive a pizza valued for as much as \$25.

13. Dress for the Weather – As the weather cools, please know that students will be going outside for recess if the wind chill is 12 degrees F and above. Please make sure your student comes to school with the proper outerwear for playing in the snow and cold.

14. Clubs and Enrichment Programs Available at Tavelli – Clubs available at Tavelli include: Kid's Yoga, Chessmates and Mad Science. Flyers are available in the parent information area in our front entrance. Stop by and pick one up today.

15. Art Room News – The art room needs empty toilet paper or paper towel tubes for the maker space. Please drop off any donations to the Tavelli office. Remember to return your Original Works packets by next Tuesday, October 16th.

16. A Few Reminders for Parents – a) If your child is absent from school, please call our attendance line at 488-6726 to let us know your child will be out of school for the day. The office needs daily notification of any absence. In case of extended absences, please let us know when your child will return. b) If your child will be changing after school dismissal plans, please be sure to send a note or give the office a call to explain the change. c) If you need to pick up your child early, please be sure to stop at the office to sign your child out. d) Students should not arrive at school before 8:35 a.m. The first bell rings at 8:50 a.m. Thank you.

17. Check Your Student's Lunch Account – If your student is purchasing hot lunch, please make sure to check the lunch balance periodically. This can be done on the [psdschools.org](https://www.psdschools.org) website, go to the quick links then to lunch menus/payments. Payments can be made online with a credit card. It is also possible to sign up for free and reduced meals on this same website. Applications for meal benefits must be renewed yearly.

18. Cash for Caps – If you have milk delivered from Morning Fresh Dairy, we can use your caps! Morning Fresh will give us 5 cents per cap we turn in. There is a collection box for your **clean** caps available in the Tavelli Office. 🌸

19. Box Tops for Education – Please remember to bring your General Mills Box Tops for Education in to the office. Tavelli collects 10 cents for every box top turned in. Please continue to save throughout the year and drop them by the office. Thank you for supporting our PTO programs. 🌸
