7. Let's Be Considerate – We are aware that student drop off and pick up continues to be a challenge and we are asking for your help. Please do not park your vehicle in front of any of our neighbor's mailboxes or driveway areas. We are also requesting that parents who park across Miramont Drive and walk across the street to pick their child up use the crosswalk and refrain from crossing in the middle of the street. For the safety of both children and drivers, we are also asking that drivers refrain from making U-turns in front of the school during drop off or pick up times.
