Registration for new PSD before- and after-school care provider opens May 1-- Selected as Poudre School District’s new provider of before- and after-school childcare, AlphaBEST opens enrollment May 1 for PSD families to sign up for services in the 2020-21 school year. A secure online registration platform will be available at alphabest.org/poudreco.

AlphaBEST's before-school programs will run 6:30 a.m. until the site school's first bell Mondays through Fridays; after-school programs will operate from the time of a site school's dismissal until 6 p.m. AlphaBEST's rates are about 20-25 percent lower, as compared with rates of PSD's former before- and after-school care provider.
